2023 Clarendon Fund Scholarships for International Students at University

of Oxford

The Clarendon Fund offers around 140 full scholarships every year to academically

excellent graduate students from all around the world. Clarendon Scholarships are

awarded on the basis of academic excellence and potential across all degree-bearing

subjects at graduate level at the University of Oxford.

The scholarships cover tuition and college fees as well as a generous grant for living

expenses, and all graduate applicants who apply for study at the University by the

January deadline, in their respective year of entry, will be automatically considered for

this prestigious scholarship funding.

The University of Oxford is a collegiate research university in Oxford, England. There

is evidence of teaching as early as 1096, making it the oldest university in the English-

speaking world and the world's second-oldest university in continuous operation. It

grew rapidly from 1167 when Henry II banned English students from attending

the University of Paris. After disputes between students and Oxford townsfolk in 1209,

some academics fled north-east to Cambridge where they established what became

the University of Cambridge. The two English ancient universities share many

common features, are jointly referred to as Oxbridge. Both are ranked among the most

prestigious universities in the world.

Eligibility criteria

You must be applying to start a new graduate course at Oxford. This includes

students who are currently studying for a master's degree at Oxford but who

will be re-applying for a DPhil (you would be eligible for funding for the DPhil).

You must be an international student. (Outside the UK/non-UK citizens)

You must be fluent in English Language

Eligible Countries: ALL

Type: Masters, PhD

Number of Scholarships: Not Specified (Several)

Value of Award: All Clarendon Scholarships cover tuition and college fees in full

and a generous grant for living expenses.

Duration of Scholarships: Clarendon Scholarships are offered for the full period

that you are liable to pay tuition fees to the University, which is usually the same as

the length of your course.

Method of Application: Apply by the December or January deadline, whichever

is relevant to your course, to be considered for a Clarendon scholarship.

Application Deadline: The closing date is in January 2023; dependent on the

course of study.
